

PVTC COVID-19 Policy Effective 10/13/2020

In addition, members or employees who had close contact for more than 15 minutes with COVID positive player, and family members of the individuals exposed also fit this category.</p> <p>Members and employees in this group as well as their same household family members will be required to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Isolate from PVTC until 14 days after exposure 2. Notify GM Kim Bridge if symptoms develop and/or positive COVID test result received during the 14 day period in which case isolation will be extended to end of infectious period for all members of the family 3. Exception will be made for individuals who can provide confirmation that they recovered from COVID during the period 3 months prior to exposure

Policy detail:

1. All visitors to the PVTC Facility shall wear a protective mask. Masks are not required when on court. Social distancing of at least 6 feet should be maintained on and off the courts. Players are encouraged to use hand sanitizer immediately before and after playing.
2. All members and guests are required to sign and return a waiver form before spending time on PVTC premises.
3. No member, guest or visitor shall enter the PVTC premises if experiencing any of the following:
 - a. Fever or chills
 - b. Cough
 - c. Shortness of breath
 - d. Loss of taste or smell
 - e. Nausea or diarrhea
 - f. Exposure to a COVID positive individual within the past 14 days
 - g. Positive COVID test
4. Any member or guest who experiences COVID symptoms and/or tests positive for COVID is required to notify the PVTC GM immediately unless he/she **and** their family members have not visited the club during the period starting 5 days prior to earliest date of symptoms or positive test.
5. Members/guests who visited the club during their infectious period (see definition in summary table) will be asked to share the locations within the club where they spent time and the names of individuals that they played tennis or pickleball with, took lessons from or otherwise had close contact and interactions with.
6. Members with symptoms and/or positive COVID test results will not return to PVTC until the following conditions outlined by the Center for Disease Control and the Los Angeles County Health Department have been met:
 - a. 10 days after positive test or when symptoms first appeared AND
 - b. 24 hours with no fever AND
 - c. Other symptoms improving
 - d. Individuals with severe case of COVID should quarantine up to 20 days after first symptoms
7. Family members of the individual who is symptomatic and/or tests positive for COVID-19 will also isolate from the club for 14 days or until each symptomatic or COVID positive family member meets the conditions in section 6 which may extend beyond 14 days.
8. Members and employees who shared a court or otherwise were identified as having close contact with a COVID positive member or guests will be notified by the PVTC GM or a member of the COVID subcommittee of possible exposure. These individuals and their same household family members will be asked to isolate from the club until the following conditions are met:
 - a. Isolate from PVTC until 14 days after exposure AND
 - b. Notify PVTC GM Kim Bridge if you or your family members develop symptoms and/or test positive for COVID during the 14 day window after exposure. Isolation from PVTC will be extended until you and your family members meet the standards that signal the end of infectious period.
 - c. Exception to a. and b. will be made for individuals who can provide confirmation that they recovered from COVID during the period 3 months prior to exposure
9. PVTC will notify our membership by email whenever we are notified of a positive COVID situation. Information shared will not include the name of the individual who tested positive but will include the dates and locations within the club that the individual spent time.
